Chair, Department of Accounting, Economics, and Finance

Park University School of Business is seeking candidates for the Department of Accounting, Economics, and Finance, one of two departments within the School of Business at Park University.

Duties include teaching undergraduate/graduate courses, supervising activities concerning faculty affairs, which will include, among others: teaching, research, and service; supervising program coordinator activities; handling departmental student affairs; and communicating departmental needs to the Dean.

Qualifications: applicants must have a doctoral degree in accounting or in a closely-related field from an accredited university. Applicants should also have a teaching, research, and service record supporting appointment as an associate or full professor. Prior experience in academic administration is preferred.

The preferred starting date for this appointment is August 1, 2012. This is a 12-month appointment and will be at the rank of associate or full professor. Compensation package will be commensurate with experience and qualifications.

Additional requirements include: a minimum of 18 graduate hours in Accounting; CPA or CMA certification preferred; ability to teach a variety of undergraduate and graduate level accounting courses, including audit, cost accounting and/or tax; strong commitment to excellence in the teaching and advising of students; commitment to university/community service and continued professional development. Preference may be given to candidates with prior experience in the role of department chair, teaching experience and/or several years of professional experience in an accounting position.

Assistant Professor of Accounting

The Park University School of Business invites applications and nominations for a full-time tenure-track position in accounting at the rank of assistant professor (higher ranks may be considered) in the Department of Accounting, Economics and Finance to begin August 1, 2012. Professionally qualified candidates with an MBA/CPA/CMA may be considered for a non-tenure-track appointment at the rank of lecturer.

Accounting is part of the core of the business curriculum and is also offered in our Bachelor of Science in Accounting program. Our diverse student body is such that many of the accounting students intern with public accounting firms and begin full-time employment at these firms upon graduation.

Requirements for the position include: Ph.D. in Accounting or a related business discipline with a minimum of 18 graduate hours in accounting. ABD may be considered; CPA/CMA certification preferred; ability to teach a variety of undergraduate and graduate level accounting courses, including audit, cost accounting and/or tax; strong commitment to excellence in the teaching and advising of students with outcomes-based practices; commitment to university/community service and continued professional development; ability and desire to contribute to additional dimensions of the university's academic program, such as serving as program coordinator for the accounting program, and the ability to work collaboratively. Preference may be given to candidates with a minimum of two years teaching experience and/or several years of professional experience in an accounting position.
